<u>HB 609</u> (Botana) and <u>SB 1144</u> (DiCeglie) Local Business Taxes – Oppose – HB 609 has passed all of its committees and is now eligible to be considered by the full House. SB 1144 has not been heard in any committee.

David Cruz Update:

 <u>HB 479</u> (W. Robinson) and <u>SB 688</u> (Martin) Alternative Mobility Funding Systems – Support – HB 479 has passed all of its committees of reference and now heads to the House floor for consideration. The next and final committee stop for SB 688 is the Senate Rules Committee. SB 688 is not on this week's Rules Committee agenda. The Rules Committee meets next week on February 26.

 <u>SB 472</u> (Brodeur) and <u>HB 569</u> (McFarland) Suits Against the Government/Sovereign Immunity – Oppose – Last week, HB 569 was temporarily postponed in its final committee, the House Judiciary Committee. The next committee stop for SB 472 is the Senate Appropriations Committee.

Jeff Branch Update:

 <u>HB 1239</u> (V. Lopez) Affordable Housing/Live Local – Monitor – HB 1239 will be heard on Tuesday, February 20 at 1:00 p.m. in the House Appropriations Committee. This is the final committee stop in the House. The Senate companion bill, <u>SB 328</u> (Calatayud), passed the full Senate and is now in House messages.

Rebecca O'Hara Update:

 <u>HB 1417</u> (Buchanan) Funding for Environmental Resource Management – Support – HB 1417 will be heard on Tuesday, February 20 at 1:00 p.m. in the House Appropriations Committee. This is the final committee stop in the House. The Senate companion bill, <u>SB 1638</u>, has passed its committees and is now eligible for consideration by the full Senate.

Sam Wagoner Update:

- <u>HB 473</u> (Giallombardo) and <u>SB 658</u> (DiCeglie) Cybersecurity Incident Liability Support The next and final committee stop for HB 473 is the House Judiciary Committee. We will know by 4:30 p.m. today if HB 473 is on the committee's February 21 meeting agenda. SB 658 has passed out of all its committees and is now eligible for consideration by the Full Senate.
- <u>HB 1537</u> (Griffitts) and <u>SB 280</u> (DiCeglie) Vacation Rentals Oppose SB 280 passed the full Senate and is House messages. The next and final committee stop for HB 1537 is the Commerce Committee. We will know by 4:30 p.m. on February 20 if HB 1537 is on the committee's February 22 meeting agenda.

 <u>HB 1365</u> (Garrison) and <u>SB 1530</u> (Martin) Unauthorized Public Camping and Public Sleeping – Monitor – The next and final committee stop for SB 1530 is the Senate Fiscal Policy Committee. We will know by 2:30 p.m. today if SB 1530 is on the committee's February 22 meeting agenda. The next and final committee stop for HB 1365 is the House Health and Human Services Committee. The next committee meeting is on February 22, and we will know by 4:30 p.m. on February 20 if HB 1365 is on the committee agenda.
