

## **ADOPT-A-HIGHWAY PROGRAM**

### **PROGRAM DESCRIPTION**

Adopt-A-Highway is a public/private partnership program where citizen groups can adopt a section of state highway with a two-year commitment of keeping their section free and clean of litter.

### **ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS**

Open to all interested community groups.

### **TYPE OF ASSISTANCE**

State incurs all costs; provides citizen volunteers an opportunity to make a difference in their local communities by participating in litter-prevention education programs such as the state's Adopt-A-Highway Program.

### **AVAILABLE FUNDING**

Volunteer based. No cost associated with the program.

### **SOURCE OF FUNDS**

Florida Department of Transportation.

### **APPLICATION PROCESS/DEADLINES**

Ongoing.
