

DRUG ABUSE RESISTANCE EDUCATION

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The Florida Department of Law Enforcement is responsible for the administration of the Drug Abuse Resistance Education (DARE) program and provides training to local law-enforcement agencies participating in the DARE program. Training is available for officers who will be teaching the new 10-week DARE elementary core curriculum, the middle school program and the DARE parent program. In addition, upon graduation from the training course, officers receive certification as a school resource officer.
