The Edward Byrne Memorial and Local Law Enforcement Block grants have been combined into the new Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program (JAG). This program allows states and local governments to support a broad range of activities to prevent and control crime and to improve the criminal justice system.
