## **PROGRAM DESCRIPTION**

The Governor's Office of Tourism, Trade and Economic Development leads international programs and protocol on behalf of the State of Florida. The office manages trade and investment programs and policies, trade missions and diplomatic visits by heads of state and dignitaries. Through both its Miami and Tallahassee units, the office serves more than 100 consular missions representing 69 nations. The office oversees initiatives that pertain to the Free Trade Area of the Americas (FTAA); the Florida International Volunteer Corps, a program currently administered by the Florida Association for Volunteer Action in the Caribbean (FAVAC); the Gulf of Mexico States Accord Secretariat; the Florida Delegation – southeast U.S./Japan Association (SEUS/Japan); and the Florida Korea Economic Cooperation Committee (FLOR/KOR).
