PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

For more than 25 years, Florida's Art in State Buildings Program has acquired artwork for public facilities built with state funds through a small set-aside of one half of one percent of appropriated funds. An individual local art selection committee selects the artwork for each new facility.

In addition, as a service to communities around the state, the program manager serves as a resource for local governments or not-for-profit entities interested in developing their own public art program.
