

URBAN DESIGN, TOWN PLANNING AND REDEVELOPMENT INITIATIVES

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Facilitation of charrette and other visual master-planning processes for local governments, not-for-profit organizations and others to produce conceptual master plans. Scale of plan drawings range from regional (towns, cities and villages) conceptual plans to blocks, streets and individual buildings. Review of local government planning framework to identify supporting regulations and procedures as well as impediments for implementation. Technical assistance to local governments and others regarding development of overlay zoning regulations, architectural design guidelines, community redevelopment plans, capital facilities plans, comprehensive plan components, and other regulatory and implementation documents. Specialized training for planning and design staffs regarding town planning, urban design and redevelopment.

MEMBERSHIP ELIGIBILITY/REQUIREMENTS/FEES

Fees vary based on the type and scope of urban design and town planning services requested. Local match is required.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION

In some instances, the Treasure Coast Regional Planning Council can utilize in-kind staff and other support from local governments to augment funding necessary for completion of projects.
