

## **VICTIMS OF CRIME ACT GRANT**

### **PROGRAM DESCRIPTION**

Under the federal Victims of Crime Act (VOCA), grant funds are made available competitively to fund proposals from eligible public and private not-for-profit organizations that provide direct services to crime victims.

### **ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS**

Public entities and private nonprofit organizations that provide direct services to crime victims.

### **TYPE OF ASSISTANCE**

Grant-in-aid program.

### **AVAILABLE FUNDING**

The amount of available funding varies annually.

### **SOURCE OF FUNDS**

U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Office for Victims of Crime.

### **APPLICATION PROCESS/DEADLINES**

Typically, the Notice of Availability for VOCA funds is published annually in January/February; the grant funding cycle is October 1 through September 30.

### **MATCHING/OTHER REQUIREMENTS**

An in-kind or cash contribution match of 20 percent is required.
