Charles Chapman Update:

- <u>SJR 1510/SB 1512</u> (Avila) Homestead Property Exemption and Assessment Limitations Oppose – The bills will be heard on March 25 at 11:00 a.m. in the Senate Community Affairs Committee. This is the first of three committee stops in the Senate.
- <u>SB 1664</u> (Trumbull) and <u>HB 1221</u> (Miller) Local Option Taxes Oppose SB 1664 will be heard on March 25 at 11:00 a.m. in the Senate Community Affairs Committee. This is the first of three committee stops in the Senate. HB 1221 passed its first committee of reference and has two more committee stops in the House.
- HB 503 (Botana) and SB 1196 (Truenow) Local Business Taxes Oppose HB 503 passed two committees and has one more committee stop, the House State Affairs Committee. The next meeting of the House State Affairs Committee is on March 26 at 11:30 a.m. We will know by 5:00 p.m. today if HB 503 is on the March 26 agenda. SB 1196 has three committee references and has not yet been heard in a committee. The first committee stop is Senate Community Affairs.

- SB 482 (DiCeglie) and HB 665 (Steele) Local Government /Impact Fees Oppose SB 482 will be heard on March 25 at 11:00 a.m. in the Senate Community Affairs Committee. This is the first of three committee stops in the Senate. HB 665 has passed its first committee of reference and has two more House committee stops.
- SB 582 (Leek) and HB 717 (Greco) Unlawful Demolition of Historical Buildings and Structures – Support – SB 582 will be heard on March 25 at 1:30 p.m. in the Senate Governmental Oversight and Accountability Committee. This is the second of three committee stops in the Senate. HB 717 has one more committee stop in the House, the House State Affairs Committee.
- <u>HB 301</u> (McFarland) and <u>SB 1570</u> (DiCelgie) Sovereign Immunity Oppose HB 301 has one more committee stop in the House, the House Judiciary Committee. The next Judiciary Committee meeting is scheduled for March 26 at 11:30 a.m. We will know by 5:00 p.m. today if HB 301 will be on the March 26 meeting agenda. SB 1570 has three committee stops and has not yet been heard in any committee.
- Update on Community Redevelopment Agencies (CRA): Neither CRA bill will be heard in a committee this week.

- <u>SB 810</u> (Burgess) **Stormwater Management Systems Oppose** SB 810 will be heard today at 1:30 p.m. in the Senate Appropriations Committee on Transportation, Tourism, and Economic Development. This is the second of three committee stops in the Senate.
- SB 818 (McClain) and HB 703 (W. Robinson) Utility Relocation Monitor SB 818 will be heard on March 25 at 4:00 p.m. in the Senate Regulated Industries Committee. This is the

first of three committee stops in the Senate. HB 703 passed its first committee of reference and has one more committee stop in the House, the House Commerce Committee.

- <u>SB 1594</u> (McClain) and **HB 923** (V. Lopez) **Tax Exemption for Affordable Housing** Oppose – SB 1594 will be heard on March 25 at 11:00 a.m. in the Senate Community Affairs Committee. This is the first of three committee stops in the Senate. HB 923 has three committee references and has not been heard in a committee.
- <u>HB 943</u> (V. Lopez) **Real Property and Land Use and Development Oppose** HB 943 will be heard on March 25 at noon in the House Housing, Agriculture & Tourism Subcommittee. This is the first of four committee stops in the House.

- <u>SB 110</u> (Simon) and <u>HB 1427</u> (Griffitts) **Rural Communities** <u>Monitor</u> HB 1427 will be heard on March 24 at 4:00 p.m. in the House Commerce Committee. This is the first of three committee stops in the House. SB 110 passed the full Senate last week.
- HB 1183 (Giallombardo) and SB 1576 (DiCeglie) Support HB 1183 will be heard on March 25 at 9:00 a.m. in the House Information Technology Budget & Policy Subcommittee. This is the first of three committee stops in the House. SB 1576 has three committees of reference and has not been heard in a committee.
