- [SB 518](#) (Brodeur) **Trees, Residential Home Protection – Support** – SB 518 will be heard today, January 18, in the Senate Community Affairs Committee at 3:30 p.m. This is the first of three committee stops in the Senate.
- [SB 280](#) (Hutson) **Local Ordinances – Oppose** – SB 280 will be heard on Thursday, January 20 at 9:30 a.m. in the Senate Rules Committee. This is the final committee stop in the Senate.
- [SB 620](#) (Hutson) **Local Government/Business Damages – Oppose** – SB 620 will be heard on Thursday, January 20 at 11:30 a.m. in the Senate Appropriations Committee. This is the final committee stop in the Senate.
