- <u>SB 970</u> (Hooper) **Firefighters' Bill of Rights** Watch SB 970 will be heard on Wednesday, March 3 at 9:30 a.m. in the Senate Community Affairs Committee. This is the first of three committee stops for SB 970. The House companion, HB 313 (Busatta Cabrera), passed its first committee of reference and has two more committee stops.
- <u>HB 15</u> (Clemons) & <u>SB 50</u> (Gruters) Sales Tax Fairness (FLC Priority) Support At this time, there is no movement on either of the bills this week. HB 15 has not yet been heard in a committee. It has two committee references: Ways & Means and Commerce. SB 50 unanimously passed its first and second committees of reference and has one more stop in the Senate, the Senate Appropriations Committee.

- <u>SB 72</u> (Brandes) Civil Liability for Damages Relating to COVID-19 Support SB 72 will be heard on Tuesday, March 2 at 1:30 p.m. in the Senate Commerce and Tourism Committee. This is the second of three committee stops. The House companion, HB 7 (McClure), has passed all three of its committees and is on 2nd Reading in the House.
- <u>SB 496</u> (Perry) Growth Management Oppose SB 496 will be heard on Wednesday, March 3 at 9:30 a.m. in the Senate Community Affairs Committee. This is the first of three committee stops. The House companion, HB 59 (McClain), has passed two committees and has one last committee stop in State Affairs.
- <u>SB 628</u> (Rouson) Urban Agriculture Support SB 628 will be heard on Wednesday, March 3 at 12:00 p.m. in the Senate Agriculture Committee. This is the first of three committee stops. The House companion, HB 1013 (Rayner), has not yet been heard in any of its three committees of reference.

This is the second of three committee stops. The House companion bill is HB 263 (Maggard) and has not yet been heard in a committee. It has three committee references.
- <u>SB 758</u> (Diaz) Fiduciary Duty of Care Oppose SB 758 will be heard on Wednesday, March 3 at 12:00 p.m. in the Senate Governmental Oversight and Accountability Committee. This is the first of three committee stops. The House companion bill is HB 573 (Beltran) and it also has three committee stops.
