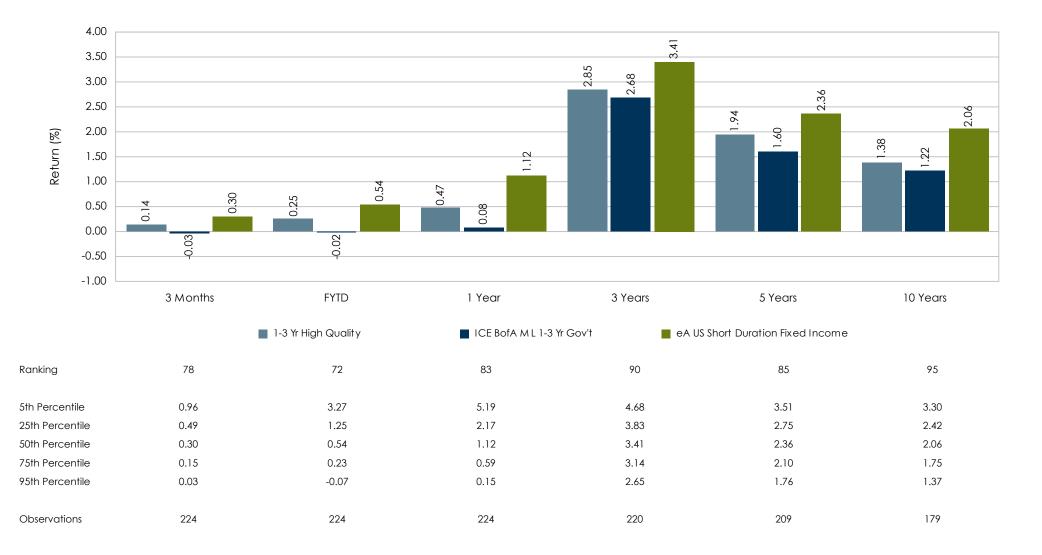

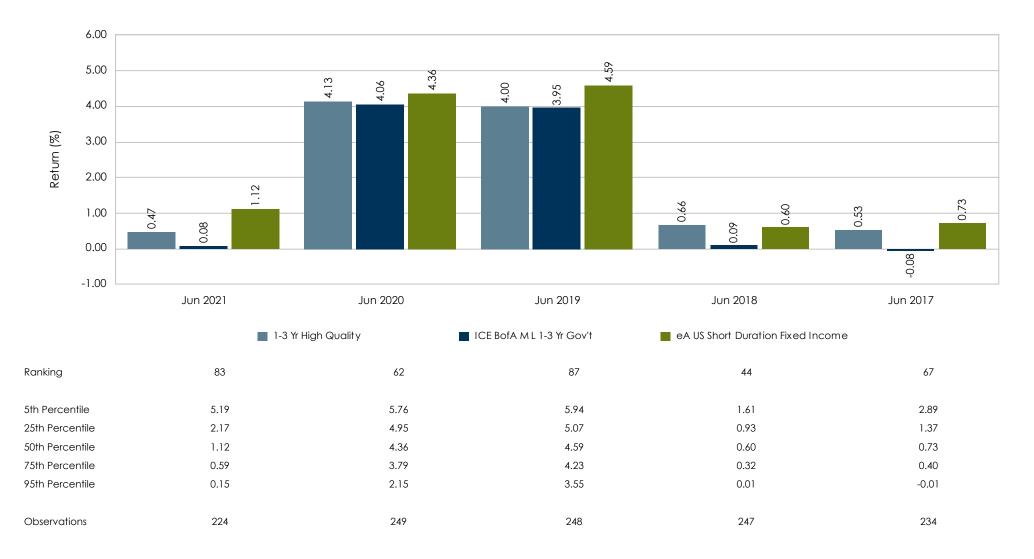
Sector Allocation
