



Grant Readiness – The Basics


- Know your numbers

Reduce Your Risk

- Set up your internal process for applications
 - Who reviews the application
 - Who approves the submittal of an application
 - Who is registered in the grantor website
- Set up your internal process for award management
 - Process for Award Acceptance
 - Reports – who completes, approves, submits
 - Checks and balances


