

Summary: February 16, 2026, FLC Monday Morning Webinar

Charles Chapman Update:

- **HB 103** (Botana) and **SB 122** (Truenow) **Local Business Taxes – Oppose** – HB 103 passed all of its committees and is on the House Special Order Calendar for consideration by the full House on Tuesday, February 17, at 1:00 p.m. SB 122 passed its first committee of reference and has two more committee stops in the Senate. The next committee stop is the Senate Finance and Tax Committee.
Ask: Continue to educate your senator on the importance of local business taxes.
- **Property Tax Update:** Three House property tax bills are ready for House Floor consideration. They are **HB 203** (Miller), **HB 209** (Busatta), and **HB 213** (Ways and Means, Griffiths). The League is opposed to all three bills, and we are watching the bills to see if they will be considered this week by the full House. The Senate has not released a property tax plan.

David Cruz Update:

- **SB 1138** (Massullo) and **HB 927** (Sapp) **Qualified Contractors – Oppose** – SB 1138 has passed two of its three committee references. The final committee stop is the Senate Rules Committee. SB 1138 is not on this week's Senate Rules Committee agenda. HB 927 passed its first committee and has two more committee stops in the House. The next committee stop is the House Commerce Committee.
- **Sovereign Immunity Update:** **HB 145** (McFarland) **Oppose** – HB 145 passed the full House on January 15 and has been sent to the Senate. **SB 1366** (Brodeur) **Monitor** – SB 1366 passed its second committee of reference last week. The next and final committee stop is the Senate Rules Committee. SB 1366 is not on this week's Senate Rules Committee agenda.

Matt Singer Update:

- **HB 1019** (Conerly) and **SB 1230** (Harrell) **Perfluoroalkyl and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances/PFAS – Monitor** – HB 1019 will be heard on Tuesday, February 17, at 8:30 a.m. in the House State Affairs Committee. This is the final committee stop in the House. SB 1230 will be heard on Wednesday, February 18, at 1:30 p.m. in the Senate Fiscal Policy Committee. This is the final committee stop in the Senate.
- **SB 840** (DiCeglie) and **HB 1465** (Andrade) **Land Use Regulations Affected by Natural Disasters/SB 180 Glitch Bill – Support** – SB 840 will be heard on Tuesday, February 17, at 12:00 p.m. in the Senate Rules Committee. This is the final committee stop in the Senate. The House companion bill, HB 1465, has not yet been heard in a House committee. The League also supports a similar bill, **HB 217** (Abbott). HB 217 has not yet been heard in a committee. The first committee stop for both HB 1465 and HB 217 is the House Intergovernmental Affairs Subcommittee.

Rebecca O'Hara Update:

- **SB 1014** (Mayfield) and **HB 1075** (Sirois) **Provision of Municipal Utility Service to Owners Outside the Municipal Limits – Oppose** – SB 1014 will be heard on Tuesday, February 17, at 12:00 p.m. in the Senate Rules Committee. This is the final committee stop in the Senate. HB 1075 passed its second committee of reference last week and has one more committee stop in the House, the House Commerce Committee.

- **SB 1724** (Martin) and **HB 1451** (Busatta) **Utility Services – Oppose** – SB 1724 will be heard on Tuesday, February 17, at 12:00 p.m. in the Senate Rules Committee. This is the final committee stop in the Senate. HB 1451 has one more committee stop in the House, the House Commerce Committee. We will know this afternoon if HB 1451 is on the Commerce Committee's February 18 meeting agenda.

- **SB 1342** (Rouson) and **HB 1183** (Cross) **Transportation Infrastructure Land Development Regulations – Oppose** – SB 1342 will be heard on Wednesday, February 18, at 8:30 a.m. in the Senate Appropriations Committee on Transportation, Tourism, and Economic Development. This is the second of three committee stops in the Senate. HB 1183 has four committees of reference and has not yet been heard in a committee.

Sam Wagoner Update:

- **Local Government Spending Update: SB 1566** (DiCeglie) and **HB 1329** (Benarroch) – **Oppose** – SB 1566 passed its first committee last week. SB 1566 has two more committee stops in the Senate. HB 1329 passed its second committee last week and has one more committee stop in the House. Neither SB 1566 nor HB 1329 will be heard in a committee this week.
- Two bills were filed this session relating to the Department of Financial Services, **HB 1303** (Miller) and **SB 1572** (DiCeglie). Neither HB 1303 nor SB 1572 has been heard in a committee. Last week, the House State Administration Budget Subcommittee filed a proposed committee bill (PCB), **SAB3 Government Administration**, that will restructure the state Auditor General. The League is monitoring this bill.
