

## Summary: March 2, 2026, FLC Monday Morning Webinar

### Charles Chapman Update:

- **HJR 203** (Miller) **Elimination of Non-school Property for Homesteads/Property Tax – Oppose** – HJR 203 passed the full House of Representatives (80-30). HJR 203 has been sent over to the Senate. The Senate has not released a property tax plan.
- **HB 103** (Botana) and **SB 122** (Truenow) **Local Business Taxes – Oppose** – HB 103 passed the full House of Representatives (82-26) and has been sent over to the Senate. SB 122 passed its first committee of reference and has two more committee stops in the Senate. March 3 is the last day of regularly scheduled Senate committee meetings, and SB 122 is not scheduled to be heard.

### David Cruz Update:

- **SB 1366** (Brodeur) **Monitor**, and **HB 145** (McFarland) **Oppose Suits Against the Government/Sovereign Immunity** – HB 145 passed the full House of Representatives (104-7). SB 1366 will be heard on March 3 at 9:00 a.m. in the Senate Rules Committee. This is the final committee stop in the Senate. An amendment has been filed to SB 1366.  
**Ask: Watch for an FLC Legislative Alert on SB 1366.**
- **SB 354** (McClain) and **HB 299** (Melo) **Blue Ribbon Projects – Oppose** – SB 354 will be heard on March 3 at 9:00 a.m. in the Senate Rules Committee. This is the final committee stop in the Senate. HB 299 passed all committees of reference and is eligible for consideration by the full House of Representatives.
- **HB 1139** (Gentry, Basabe) and **SB 548** (McClain) **Impact Fees – Oppose** – HB 1139 is on the March 4 House Special Order Calendar for consideration by the full House. SB 548 still has two committee stops in the Senate. March 3 is the last day of regular scheduled Senate committee meetings, and SB 548 is not scheduled to be heard. However, impact fee language is in a recently filed amendment to SB 1566 (DiCeglie), the Local Government Spending bill. SB 1566 will be heard in the Senate Rules Committee on March 3.

### Matt Singer Update:

#### Biosolids Update (3 sets of bills):

- **SB 290** (Truenow) and **HB 433** (D. Alvarez) **Dept. of Agriculture and Consumer Services/Farm Bill – Oppose** – SB 290 passed the full Senate (38-0). Both SB 290 and HB 433 are on the March 3 House Special Order Calendar for consideration by the full House of Representatives.
- **HB 1245** (Shoaf) and **SB 1294** (Bradley) **Biosolids Management – Monitor** – HB 1245 is on the March 4 House Special Order Calendar for consideration by the full House of Representatives. SB 1294 passed all committees of reference and is now eligible to be considered by the full Senate.
- **HB 1285** (Boyles) and **SB 1474** (Gaetz) **Biosolids Management – Monitor** – HB 1285 is on the March 4 House Special Order Calendar for consideration by the full House of Representatives. SB 1474 passed all committees of reference and is now eligible to be considered by the full Senate.

### Rebecca O'Hara Update:

- **SB 1548** (Calatayud) **Monitor**, and **HB 1389** (Redondo) **Oppose Affordable Housing/Live Local** – SB 1548 is scheduled to be heard twice this week. The first committee hearing is on March 2 at 12:00 p.m. in the Senate Fiscal Policy Committee. The next and final committee hearing is on March 3 at 9:00 a.m. in the Senate Rules Committee. HB 1389 is on the March 4 House Special Order Calendar for consideration by the full House of Representatives.

- **HB 399** (Borrero) and **SB 208** (McClain) **Land Use and Development Regulations – Monitor** – HB 399 is on the March 3 House Special Order Calendar for consideration by the full House of Representatives. SB 208 passed all committees of reference and is now eligible for consideration by the full Senate.
- **HB 1451** (Busatta) and **SB 1724** (Martin) **Utility Services – Oppose** – HB 1451 is on the March 3 House Special Order Calendar for consideration by the full House of Representatives. SB 1724 passed all committees of reference and is now eligible for consideration by the full Senate.

### Sam Wagoner Update:

- **SB 1566** (DiCeglie) and **HB 1329** (Benarroch) **Local Government Spending – Oppose** – SB 1566 will be heard in its final committee, Senate Rules, on March 3 at 9:00 a.m. HB 1329 passed all committees of reference and is on the March 4 House Special Order Calendar for consideration by the Full House of Representatives.

- **SB 576** (Harrell) and **HB 1085** (Miller) **Local Government Cybersecurity – Support** – SB 576 will be heard on March 2 at 12:00 p.m. in the Senate Appropriations Committee. This is the bill's final committee stop. HB 1085 is on the March 4 House Special Order Calendar for full consideration by the House of Representatives.
