

## Summary: March 9, 2026, FLC Monday Morning Webinar

### Charles Chapman Update:

- The Legislature will not pass a budget this week. A special session on the budget and a special session on property taxes are likely. Continue educating legislators and members of the public on property taxes.

### David Cruz Update:

- **SB 1366** (Brodeur) and **HB 145** (McFarland) **Suits Against the Government/Sovereign Immunity** – **Oppose** – HB 145 passed the full House of Representatives (104-7). SB 1366 is on the March 10 Senate Special Order Calendar for consideration by the full Senate.

### Matt Singer Update:

- **SB 1220** (Massullo) and **HB 1233** (Griffitts) **Transportation** – **Oppose** – SB 1220 passed the Senate last week (35-1) and is now in House Messages. HB 1233 passed all committees and is eligible for consideration by the full House of Representatives (along with SB 1220).
- **HB 655** (Duggan) and **SB 332** (Bradley) **Public Meetings/Attorney Meetings to Discuss Private Property Rights Claims** – **Support** – HB 655 passed both chambers, and the bill is now headed to the Governor for approval.

### Rebecca O’Hara Update:

- **SB 1014** (Mayfield) and **HB 1075** (Sirois) **Utility Services** – **Oppose** – SB 1014 passed the Senate and is on the March 9 House Special Order Calendar for consideration by the House. HB 1075 passed all committees of reference and is eligible for consideration by the full House of Representatives.
- **SB 1548** (Calatayud) and **HB 1389** (Redondo) **Affordable Housing/Live Local** – **Monitor** – HB 1389 passed the House and was sent over to the Senate. The Senate substituted the Senate bill for the House bill, amended the House bill, and passed the House bill (34-0). HB 1389 is now headed back to the House in returning messages.
- **HB 399** (Borrero) and **SB 208** (McClain) **Land Use and Development Regulations** – **Monitor** – HB 399 passed the House last week (71-38) and is now awaiting action by the Senate. SB 208 is on the March 11 Senate Special Order Calendar for consideration by the full Senate.

### Sam Wagoner Update:

- **HB 1329** (Benarroch) and **SB 1566** (DiCeglie) **Local Government Spending** – **Monitor** – The House passed HB 1329 (82-28) and sent the bill over to the Senate. The Senate substituted the Senate bill for the House bill, amended the House bill, and sent the House bill back over to the House in returning messages.
- **SB 576** (Harrell) and **HB 1085** (Miller) **Local Government Cybersecurity** – **Support** – The House passed HB 1085 (109-0) and sent the bill over to the Senate. SB 576 is on the March 11 Senate Special Order Calendar for consideration by the full Senate.
