PROPOSED TAX REFORM

City of Weston to Lose \$23 Million in Revenue

Fiscal Year 2026 Total Budget \$72,500,000

The City of Weston (City) depends primarily on property taxes to fund City services. The City does not have a significant commercial tax base. 88% of our City is residential, and 62% of those residences are homesteaded – resulting in a \$23 million loss in revenue, if property taxes were eliminated from homesteaded properties.


